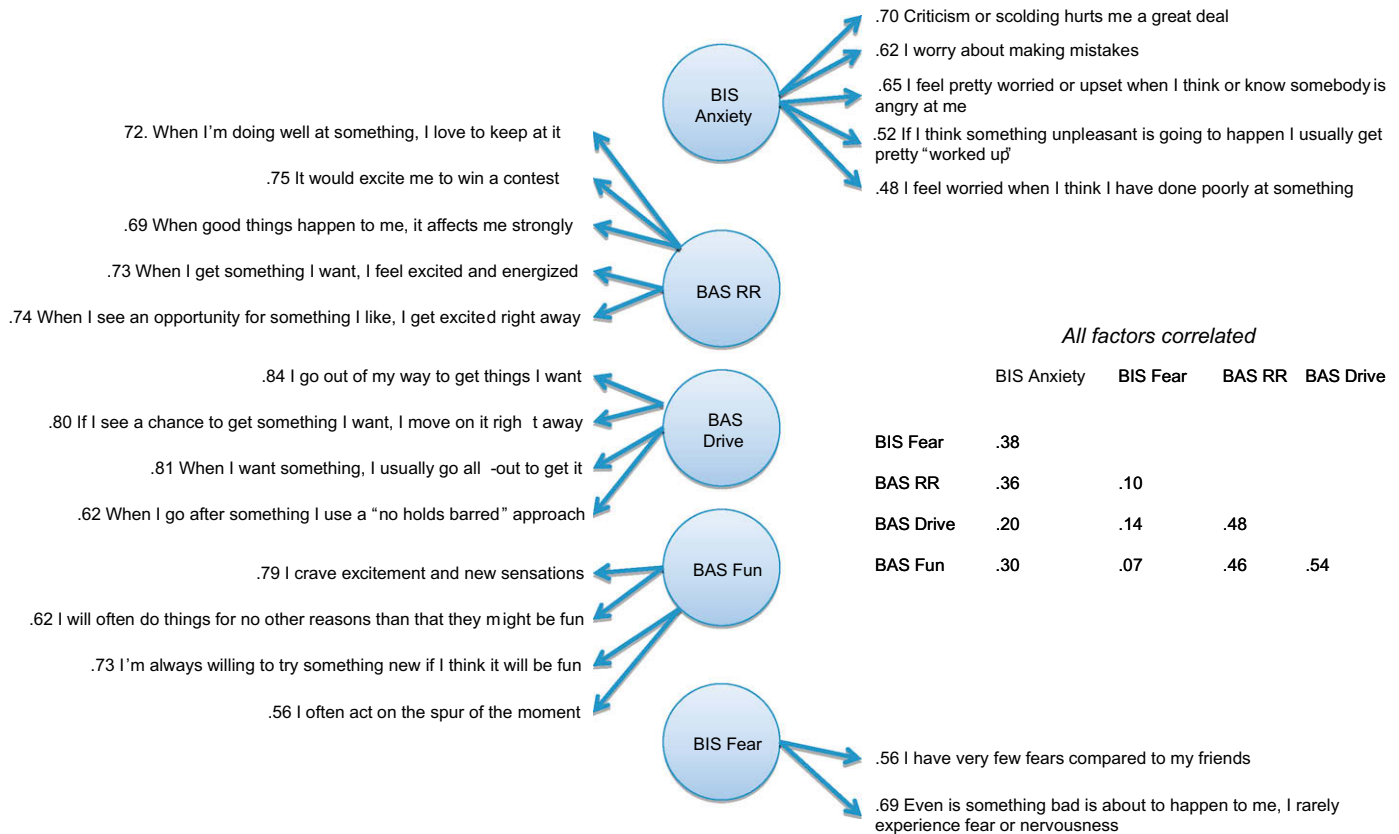


Fig. 1. Factor structure of the BIS/BAS scales.
